## How The Beatles Rocked The Kremlin

BRITISH FILMMAKER Leslie Woodhead remembers the first time he heard The Beatles perform live in a Liverpool cellar in 1962.

"The music roared up to meet me as we felt our way down the stairs," he recalls. "A few days later, we shot the first-ever film with The Beatles, a sweaty lunchtime session in The Cavern."

That grainy two-minute film served as the genesis for How The Beatles Rocked The Kremlin, Woodhead's exploration of Beatlemania in the former Soviet Union. Even though The Beatles never performed there, their music and

rebellious style influenced Russian youth. On the 20th anniversary of the fall of the Berlin Wall, this film explores how the Fab Four gave young people hope and contributed to the decline of the Soviet system.


